Conditions:

- If selected to perform with the orchestra, applicants must be available for rehearsals with the orchestra from the evening of Wednesday 30th June through to Friday 2nd July and again on Saturday morning 3rd July.
- Audio – an audio recording of the soloist playing their selected aria or concerto movement (accompaniment not required) must be included with the completed application form. Mp3 is the preferred format.
- The music selected must be out of copyright and available in New Zealand.
- Permission to Use – the soloists give permission for the NSO to record an audio/video of the concert and to livestream the concert. The NSO shall possess ownership of the recording and maintain the right to use it for public promotion.
- All travel and accommodation are at the applicant's expense.
